


## English Handout!

*Not all clothes are preceded by an article.*


☺ Only clothes that are **singular** must be preceded by an **article**: "a".

Example:

"I'm wearing **a** green skirt" →  → 1 thing

☹ But if you talk about clothes that are **plural**, you **don't need that article!**

Example:

"He's wearing brown shoes" →  → 2 things

With "a"	Without "a"
She's wearing a skirt	She's wearing shoes
He's wearing a shirt	He's wearing blue trousers
She's wearing a jumper	She's wearing pink socks
